2018 Parade Date: Sunday, December 2, 2018 at 3:00 pm -- RAIN OR SHINE
2018 Application Deadline: Monday, November 26, 2018

Parade Route: The parade starts at Highway 17 Business at **Sunnyside Avenue**. The line-up will occur in the large vacant lot adjacent to Prosser's BBQ. The parade will head south to Wachesaw Road along Hwy 17 Business. The parade will turn west on Wachesaw Road and will disband there. Please note that the parade route is 1.3 miles long.

2018 MURRELLS INLET CHRISTMAS PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS



1. There is a \$15 parade entry fee **and one unwrapped toy for the USMC Toys for Tots drive.** Fees are waived for schools, and police and fire department entries and other non-profits.
2. Each parade entry is limited to five vehicles per unit (i.e., any combination of cars, trucks, boats, floats, motorcycles, bicycles, golf carts or any other vehicle).
3. The 2018 Murrells Inlet Parade Committee maintains the right to control the type and number of participants in the parade. Applications are due by 4:00 pm on November 26, 2018.
4. The purpose of the parade is to provide enjoyment for the members of our community, especially for the children. **MAKE IT FUN FOR THE KIDS!** Decorate, Decorate, Decorate! Dress Up! Show your Christmas spirit!
5. A panel of children judges, located along the parade route, will pick the best entry. An email announcing the winner will be sent to all participants and the community after the parade.
6. The official Santa Claus will ride in the fire truck at the end of the parade. Please do not dress up like Santa, so we don't confuse the children.
7. Please no throwing of candy or objects to the viewers during the parade due to liability, safety and litter concerns. You may walk beside your unit and hand out candy or other items.
8. No horses or other large animals are allowed to walk in the parade. Small pets walking in the parade or sitting on trucks or floats must be leashed and under the control of a human. All animal droppings must be picked up by participants.
9. Animal owners are solely responsible for the action of their animals. Owners should verify with their insurance companies to ensure their pets' participation in parades are covered under their business or homeowner insurance policies.
10. You are responsible for the safety of your participants & the safety of the spectators along the street. Take no actions that would endanger your members and/or the spectators.
11. All vehicle drivers must be 18 years & older, possess a valid driver's license & able to produce proof of insurance at parade, if asked.
12. Tailgates & trailer sides must be up during the parade. Please keep all body limbs inside the vehicle
13. Given the absence of curbs along the parade route, all vehicles must maintain a **5 mph** speed limit and maintain a straight line down the center line.
14. Please keep up the parade pace. Do not let gaps form between you & the entry in front of you.
15. We ask for your cooperation, patience & your best holiday spirit during the parade line-up. You will not be assigned a specific parade unit number. We will line you up in the large lot on Sunnyside Avenue (adjacent to Prosser's BBQ). You will receive an email on 11/29/18, informing you of your line-up location and check-in procedures.
16. Do NOT park any personal cars in the line-up lots.
17. All participants must be loaded & ready to roll by 2:30 pm or you will not be permitted in the parade! **THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
18. Your parade members can be dropped off at a location determined by your group. You can station a member there to meet your children drop-offs.
19. All entries must follow the parade route from start to finish. Please plan your walkers accordingly knowing that the route is 1.3 miles.
20. No refunds issued for cancellations or no-shows. There will be a \$30 service charge on all returned checks.
